- We successfully concluded the planning phase of a new Project called "Churches Blessing the City of León" which will be implemented in 2022.
- Over 100 people participated and expressed gratitude for the emotional healing and the strengthening of their faith through the trauma healing circles.
- IMPACT Clubs saw many youth from different neighborhoods grow closer in their relationship with God; not to mention the fun moments many experienced during the vocational courses that they were taught.
- The Shalom conferences provided by the Nehemiah Center exceeded all the expectations.
- Over 40 pastoral teams from local churches worked to develop new and creative activities to promote the "Shalom of God" for the city.


Martín Alonso Lacayo, Replenish Retreat
