# Words from the General Supervisor

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

“We praise God because He is good!”

It is such a pleasure to share these words with you. God has worked wonders in every moment of 2025. His faithful love and compassion have accompanied us.

We were able to accompany 124 churches in Nicaragua this past year, which participated in the various initiatives offered by the Nehemiah Center. This allowed the church to have a greater understanding of the gospel in a holistic way and live it out, contributing to transformation all around.

More than 500 participants received training in Church Strengthening. The Nehemiah Center accompanied them to strengthen their spiritual and ministerial areas, providing them with tools to share with their congregations and give them encouragement to continue living the gospel and impact their communities.

The training sessions on spiritual and ministerial topics were held primarily in the cities of Managua and Carazo. These are cities where the Nehemiah Center has been working systematically, where there is a great need to learn about a Biblical worldview. To learn how the church, as an agent of transformation, can intervene through the light of the gospel and impact lives with the help of the Holy Spirit.

In other parts of the country, we were able to provide spiritual and holistic mission support to more than 1,600 people. This was achieved in cities in western Nicaragua, such as León and Chinandega, as well as in other cities on a smaller scale, including Managua, Masaya, Matagalpa, Carazo, and Ocotal (in the Pacific and North Central regions of Nicaragua).

We were able to support the participating churches, strengthening their capacity to live and proclaim a holistic gospel. Many of these churches have been affected by social issues such as migration, gender-based violence, and other situations that require restoration and inner healing. Also there is such a need for educational institutions to learn how to provide dignified support to people with disabilities, especially children, adolescents, and young adults. Through various training programs, these areas have been strengthened.

Once again, we acknowledge that God goes before us, and without Him, nothing is possible. We thank all of you for allowing us to continue collaborating, to transform the lives of those who have had the opportunity to participate this year.

# Program

## Highlights

More than **2,600** people benefited directly from the ministries and programs of the Nehemiah Center.

**31** teenagers accepted and were baptized in the Youth Discipleship program in the cities of León and Managua.

**124** churches participated in Nehemiah Center programs

**145** youth from churches in Nicaragua were blessed through Youth Discipleship

More than **300** participants received training in church strengthening

**44** people improved their financial situations through Good Sense

**243** church leaders received training in important topics for their churches; Conflict Resolution, Trauma Healing Circles and Peaceful Fellowship in the cities of León y Chinandega.

**76** youth learned the importance of Creation Care

**102** parents in 9 churches reflected on the "Role of fathers and mothers" in the cities of Managua and León.

**145** youth from churches in Nicaragua were blessed through Youth Discipleship

**60** pastors and ministry leaders committed to "The Care and Stewardship of Creation"

More than **1,100** students benefited through 3 projects: school infrastructure improvements, painting, and 1 computer provision project.

**129** people started to save money through 9 Savings and Loan programs in 9 churches. This project concluded in 2025
